## **Kindergarten Start-up Activities Timeline**

Our kindergarten teachers begin placement screening our incoming kindergarteners two days before our other grades start school in August. This allows us to build balanced homeroom class lists the way our Bethel Advisory School Board Policy on Placement requires. Our placement screener also gives teachers extremely helpful information about what each child needs for instruction. Here is the timeline of activities for kindergarten placement in August:

1. August 2<sup>nd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>, 2021: ME School staff will be calling parents of incoming kindergarteners to make placement screening appointments.
2. August 10<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> (and possibly AM of the 12<sup>th</sup>): ME School kindergarten teachers will be screening all enrolled kindergarteners for placement.
3. Thursday, August 12<sup>th</sup>, 2021: ME School kindergarten teachers will call the students placed in their classrooms to let kindergarten parents know which teacher they have.
  - a. Traditionally ME School “Meet Your Teacher” open house is held the evening before kindergarten starts. We will send details closer to the start of school about how this event may be adapted to meet COVID mitigation requirements.
4. Friday, August 13<sup>th</sup> is the first day of kindergarten at ME for the 2021-2022 school year.

You can expect more news to come about bus route schedules, arrival and dismissal details, and more information that will help you prepare for the coming kindergarten year. Bethel Advisory School Board Policy  
Student Placement and Classroom Assignments

All classrooms will maintain, as much as possible, equal numbers of students and equal proportions of:

1. Girls and Boys;
2. Cultural, racial, and linguistic diversity;
3. Advanced, average, and low developmental proficiencies;
4. Special needs and behavior issues;
5. Older and younger children (birthdays before and after February 15)

Conditions for classroom distribution of students may be waived by the site administrator for specific programmatic needs such as special education, developmental appropriateness, and English language development.

If parents have concerns about the compatibility of a specific teacher's style of instruction and their child's learning style, the parents may request that their child not be assigned to the teacher's classroom. A written request should be submitted to the Site Administrator by August 10. The administration will grant the request if it can be done without altering the conditions listed above.

This policy will be distributed by April 15 of each year, and will be made available parents during Kindergarten enrollment.

LKSD Board of Education Policy 8232 states: "All grade and class placement of students shall be determined by the site administrator with the assistance of the teachers involved. Parents shall have the right to appeal grade or class assignment to: (1) the site administrator, (2) the Advisory School Board, in that order. The decision of the Advisory School Board shall be binding."
